The Indigenous Community Legal Worker (ICLW) at Duncan/Nanaimo can:

Give you legal information and limited advice about:

- child and spousal support
- parenting responsibilities (formerly custody), parenting time, and guardianship
- wills, estates, and probate
- child protection issues
- housing
- Indian residential and day schools

Explain the legal process to you, and:

- attend court with you,
- help you prepare forms and letters, and
- take part in negotiations.

Talk on your behalf to:

- the Ministry of Children and Family Development,
- legal aid lawyers,
- duty counsel, or
- your band, Nation, or tribe.

Refer you to other services, such as:

- Access Pro Bono
- Lawyer Referral Service
- Parents Legal Centre

You can expect:

- a culturally safe place to speak freely, and
- enough time to ask questions to understand your options.
